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BYLAW REQUIREMENTS (General Summary - Read Sections 3 through 6)

- 1. Burning is limited to the specific area and material approved within the permit.
- 2. Weather and wind conditions must be favorable in order to have a fire.
- 3. The fire shall be supervised by a competent adult equipped with sufficient equipment to control and to contain the fire to prevent the spread of the fire that would endanger or put at risk other properties or premises.
- 4. No burn pile can be within four (4) meters of a structure, fence or property line.
- 5. No burning of "prohibited materials" as defined under Section 1(17) of Bylaw 2021-50.
- 6. Fires that create an annoyance or irritation to adjacent persons, properties or premises shall be extinguished.
- 7. The bearer of this permit, who sets an open air fire within the Town of Tecumseh, shall be liable for all costs incurred by the Town, included but not limited to the costs of equipment and personnel required for response by Tecumseh Fire and Rescue Services, personnel and other agencies called to control and extinguish said fire on a Full Cost Recovery Basis, and in accordance with the Town's current Administrative Fees and Charges Bylaw.
- 8. Any person who contravenes any provision(s) of this bylaw is guilty of an offense.
