## Re-Opening of the Bert Lacasse Ball Park



## New Amenities and Events at Lakewood Park

After Canada Day celebrations, the Lakewood Park South project will commence, adding an all-ages water feature; an all-season washroom; a picnic shelter/pavilion; a natural amphitheatre; a natural gas firepit; Bocce courts and an event plaza!

## Stormwater Infrastructure Improvements

The Town's major flood resiliency project is progressing. Funded in part by Canada's Disaster Mitigation & Adaptation Fund (DMAF), the project improves regional stormwater infrastructure in St. Clair Beach along Riverside Drive. This year, the existing Scully and St. Mark's storm pump stations are being decommissioned and a new consolidated Scully-St. Mark's storm pump station is being constructed with 5 times the original pump capacity. A new storm trunk sewer is also being installed on a section of Riverside Drive. These stormwater infrastructure improvements are crucial to reducing flood vulnerability. The Town has created an interactive Capital Works map that provides a summary of the capital projects happening throughout the Municipality.



## Branding Our Shopping Areas

The three main shopping areas in Tecumseh are about to be re-branded! These areas include Manning Road & Amy Croft Drive, Tecumseh Road corridor and Lesperance South at CR22. Working together with the Tecumseh BIA and the Municipality of Lakeshore, the Town has retained a consultant to develop a brand identity and voice for each of these areas. The branding will help businesses in these areas to successfully market to local and regional audiences. Local businesses, residents and key stakeholders will help identify the right branding. ## Prevent Flooding in Your Home!

The Town of Tecumseh Foundation Drain Disconnection and Backwater Valve Installation Subsidy Program provides financial subsidies to residents who disconnect foundation drains that are connected to the sanitary sewer and/or install a backwater valve on the internal plumbing system in an existing home.

The subsidy for the disconnection of foundation drains from the sanitary sewer is up to 50% of the cost to \$1,060 maximum. The subsidy for the installation of a backwater valve device on the internal plumbing system in existing homes is up to 80% of the cost to \$800 maximum.
