

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF TECUMSEH

BY-LAW 2011- 10

Being a by-law to amend By-law No. 2003-57, being a by-law providing for the regulation of fencing within the Town.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 11 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25, a municipality may pass a by-law providing for the regulation of fences with the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh enacted By-law No. 2003-57, being a by-law providing for the regulation of fences within the municipality on the 12th day of August, 2003;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh is desirous of amending By-law No. 2003-57;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF TECUMSEH HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. **That** By-law No. 2003-57 is hereby amended by:

Deleting paragraph 4.8 and replacing it with the following paragraph:

4.8 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 2.5, no person shall, erect, have, permit, construct or maintain a fence which, by reason of location or design, obstructs the vision of drivers, either when leaving a roadway from another roadway or driveway, or which obstructs or detracts from the visibility or effectiveness of any traffic sign or control device on a public street or which, for any other reason, constitutes a hazard. For the purpose of this section a fence shall include a row or hedge of closely planted trees, bushes or shrubs.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed this 25th day of January 25, 2011.
